To access these databases off campus: Your Barcode or Username is simply an “S” followed by your Student ID Number (Example: S123456). Your PIN is the last four digits of your Social Security Number (Example: 6789).

- G. [County and City Data Book](#) [R 317.3 C855] - This is published about every five years and is intended as a supplement for the above that emphasizes data for counties, metropolitan areas, and states.
- H. [State Profile: Ohio](#) [R 338.9771 S797] - Similar to the above but is published annually by Woods & Poole Economics, a private organization.
